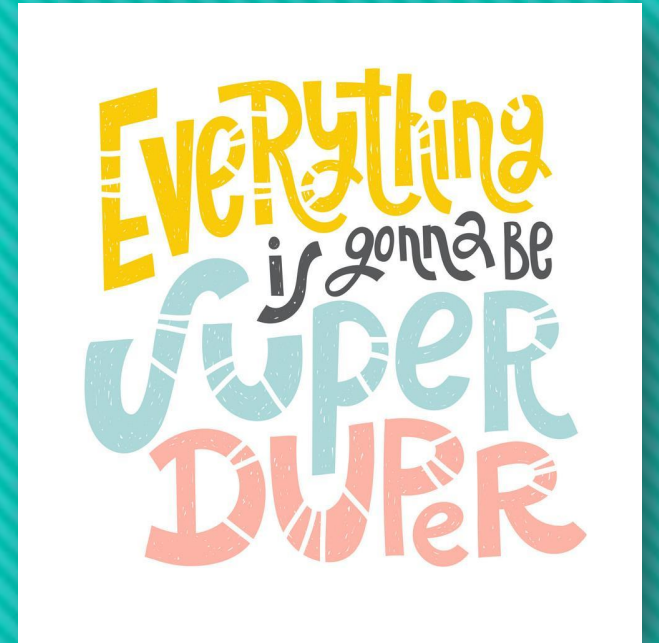
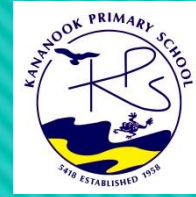

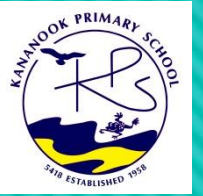


What is Freedom Friday?

THEME OF THE DAY



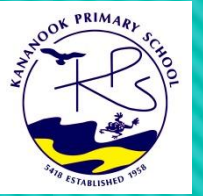
Police Appreciation Day

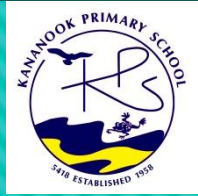

Please use this list as a guide when selecting what you can do on Freedom Fridays:

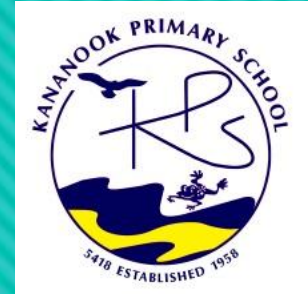
- repeat activities that you really enjoyed during the week
