Health and safety measures to reduce the risk of coronavirus (COVID-19) transmission in schools

A combination of strategies is required to minimise transmission risk. These strategies are informed by the COVIDSafe School principles and DHHS advice: Reinforce COVIDSafe behaviours, create COVIDSafe space, promote COVIDSafe activities and respond to COVID-19 risk. Not every measure will always be feasible and applicable to all education settings. Where some controls are not feasible, others should be enhanced.

COVID-19 Safety Management Plan (COVIDSafe Plan).	Use of face masks and personal protective equipment as outlined in the Operations Guide.	Hand hygiene practices.	Enhanced cleaning.
Physical distancing practices as outlined in the Operations Guide.	Information and training on infection prevention and control.	Minimising use of shared equipment when practical.	Unwell staff and students must not be on-site.
Local consultation with all staff, through Health and Safety Representatives and Health and Safety Committees (if applicable).	Limited access to school grounds by visitors, contractors.	Record keeping protocols for all staff, students, visitors and contractors on-site.	Processes to minimise number of staff or contractors working across multiple sites.
Efficient and responsive school closure process.	Processes to manage safe school arrival and departure.	Increased outdoor ventilation and where practical, delivery of class and other activities in outdoor spaces.	Strategies to reduce the mixing of different school cohorts, such as different classes or year levels.
