

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL

SRC operates at Kananook so that all students have a forum through which they can communicate their ideas and make positive contributions to the school.

The purpose of the SRC is to:

- Provide a forum for students to have input into issues and events that occur at school
- Develop leadership for children chosen to be SRC representatives
- Introduce the students to democratic procedures for the election of SRC representatives
- Introduce SRC members to the procedure for meetings during SRC meetings

The SRC will consist of the 2 School Captains and 8 elected members from Years 5 and 6. All senior students will have input into the selection criteria, based on the Student Code of Conduct, prior to the election.

The SRC election will be held in Term 1 each year. Badges will be presented at assembly to the elected members. Meetings will be held fortnightly. Class visits will take place on alternate weeks.

Some SRC duties or tasks may include:

Fundraising for the State Schools Relief Committee

Reporting to the school community via assemblies and the newsletter

Assisting with the SRC Canteen

Participating in the running of the meetings either as chairperson or minute taker

Discussing school issues or events

Highlighting the good things about Kananook

The teacher leading SRC and SRC members will comment on the success of the SRC activities and make recommendations for change.

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
