Contactable Hours

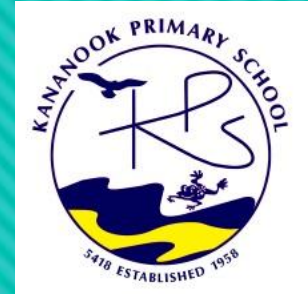
Every effort will be made to get back to you ASAP.
